FORMAL METHODS: CHALLENGES IN THE BUSINESS WORLD

The 2nd South-East European Workshop on Formal Methods (SEEFM05) took place in Ohrid on November 18-19, 2005. It was jointly organised by CITY Liberal Studies, the South-East European Research Center (SEERC) and Sts. Cyril and Methodius University as a satellite event of the 2nd Balkan Conference on Informatics.

The successful organisation of the 1st South-East European Workshop in Formal Methods that took place in Thessaloniki on the 20th of November 2003, fulfilled its goal by bringing people from SEE together, based on their common interest in Formal Methods. The aim of the 2nd workshop was to bring together more researchers of South-Eastern European countries and not only, who are interested in Formal Methods.
